Appendix I.

Gluten-free standard for the NCV (Dutch coeliac society) licensing

Products must comply with the following criteria:

1. Products **must not contain** wheat, rye, barley, spelt, Khorasan wheat (sometimes sold commercially as Kamut®) or their hybridised strains as deliberate ingredients.

The current level for licensing the Crossed Grain symbol is 20 parts per million (ppm), as defined in the Codex Alimentarius.

2. For your information the **Codex Alimentarius:**

*** Foods containing 20 ppm or less gluten**

Foods that contain 20 ppm or less will be able to be labelled 'gluten-free'. This labelling term may apply to naturally gluten-free products, products which contain gluten-free (Codex) wheat starch and pure, uncontaminated oat products which contain no more than 20 ppm gluten.

3. Food, products or raw materials used in production must not be contaminated with any gluten-containing cereals during production or storage.

4. Oat products may be licensed as long as they are uncontaminated by gluten-containing cereals in all stages of production, e.g. milling, processing, storage and packaging. Uncontaminated oats are considered safe for most people with coeliac disease; however, some people with coeliac disease may be sensitive to them. If uncontaminated oat ingredients are used in a product that is 'gluten-free', the oat ingredient must have a gluten content that is 20 ppm or less.
